Notes on Some of Our Prizes

Clisdell Trophy for most improved English student in Years 7-10: Provided by the parents of former student Robert Clisdell.

Tully Trophy for Junior Public Speaking: Donated by Mrs Judy Tully, in honour of her late husband.

Nell & Ted Ray Prize: In honour of Mr and Mrs Edwin Ray, next door neighbours and long-standing friends to The Scots School. The Agriculture Centre is named in honour of Mr Ray. Their daughters Miss Lorna Ray and Mrs Nan Hunt are still associated with the school.

Helen Geddes Prize for Junior Music: Donated by Mrs Helen Geddes, former Head of Music.

The Thompson Perpetual Trophy for Strings Work: Donated by Mr Colin and Mrs Fiona Thompson. Mrs Thompson taught strings at The Scots School for a number of years and their children contributed greatly to music. First awarded 2007.

Old Bandsmen's Trophy: Donated by the members of the original Pipes & Drums.

The McDermid Family Prize for Contribution to Boarding: awarded to a student who has earned the respect of other boarders and boarding staff for embracing the boarding way of life and to recognise their contribution to the betterment of boarding for all students. First awarded 2013.

Best Cadet Bandsman Shield: First awarded in 1981; donated by Greg Parkinson.

Roy Bootes Memorial Prize: In memory of Roy Bootes, a former student. This endowment is awarded to a student who has worked hard and is recognized as making a genuine effort to achieve their very best in all areas. It allows the student to pursue an outdoor training or camp activity.

Walter Gibbs Hunt Prize: Donated by his wife, Mrs Nan Hunt (daughter of Mr and Mrs Edwin Ray).

The Dowey Prize: Donated by parents of Christopher Dowey, a student at the school until 1984; awarded annually to a Year 9 student.

Hamish Wallace Memorial Prize for consistent work over six years to achieve their very best in all areas: Hamish Wallace lost his life in a tragic plane crash in the Blue Mountains. First awarded in 1994; during his time at The Scots School Hamish Wallace was involved in Pipes & Drums, Sport, Drama, Debating and Music.

Damien Dutch Memorial Prize: Based on concern for others, helping others, being fair minded and a good influence. Endowed in memory of Damien Dutch who died from cancer in 1987.

Herbert Prize: Donated by Mr Herbert, a former parent, and manager of the school farm. It is awarded for all-round progress and contribution to school life in Year 11.

A.E. McLucas Prize: This prize is named for the second Headmaster of The Scots School Bathurst. It is awarded to a Year 12 student who has made an all-round contribution to school life.

Old Coerwullian's Prize: Early council members of The Scots School had attended primary school in Coerwull School in Lithgow and named the prize after their school.

Lee Dennett Memorial Prize: Founded by the teaching staff in memory of Lee Dennett, who faced brave challenges in a battle against cancer until his death in Year 9, in 1996.

The Jamie Saba Memorial Trophy for Junior Cricket: This trophy is sponsored by the family of Mr Jamie Saba who was an old boy of The Scots School (1964-66). J.M. Hampshire Cup: Donated by parents of a former student.

Murray Richardson Trophy: Named for an early student at the school who was a keen cricketer.

Glasson Trophy: Named for Andrew Glasson, an ex-cricketer.

Fred Bennett Trophy: Fred Bennett played tennis for Australia and at the White City Championship and coached The Scots School Tennis Team for some 30 years.

A.E. Sweet Cup: Old boy Robert Sweet donated this prize in honour of his father.

Farrington Cup: Named after Australian champion John Farrington, a former student.

R.G. Sweet Cup: Donated by old boy Robert Sweet.

Crichton Trophy: Named for a past student.

Perry Taylor Cup: Named for a past member of the school council.
