Entry Fee: \$12.00 per class

ONE ARENA WILL BE RUNNING

THERE WILL BE A LIMIT OF 20 RIDERS PER CLASS.

Venue: The McKibbon Oval, The Scots School, Oberon Rd, Bathurst, 2795

Parking: Oval in front of the school farm. Take 2nd entrance into the school from the Bathurst side, take the first road on the left and park in that area. To reach the competition area riders will walk their horses along the bunted off pathway behind the sports barn. Horses are NOT to be warmed up in the parking area.

One horse one rider policy (please indicate if you would like to be considered for a second horse should entries allow this)

AM7: One round and if clear, a jump off against the clock is ridden.

Super 2 Phase : if first half of course is ridden clear then the second half is against the clock. Competitors will be placed according to their penalties and time in the second phase and, if necessary, to their penalties and time in the first phase.

(events may change without notification)

Class 1 will be able to walk the course at 8.00 and will start jumping at 8.30am sharp in draw order

Presentations will occur at the end of each class.

There will be an overall Champion for each of the heights classes with points awarded as follows:

1st Place = 5 Points

2nd Place = 4 Points

3rd Place = 3 Points

4th Place = 2 Points

5th Place = 1 Point

Championship presentation will be made after the completion of the last event of that particular height class. All riders are encouraged to attend this presentation. Riders will only be able to qualify for champion if both rounds are ridden.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The event is open to both Primary and Secondary students but all students will compete as per classes above. All riders must be able to ride independently.

A GRADING CARD OR LETTER FROM A QUALIFIED INSTRUCTOR MUST BE ATTACHED TO ENTRIES TO STATE THE RIDER AND HORSE COMBINATION ARE CAPABLE OF JUMPING THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT OF THE HIGHEST CLASS ENTERED. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF THIS LETTER IS NOT ATTACHED.

There are a limited number of entries (20 allowed in each class.) Entries will be accepted in order of arrival (subject to cheques and indemnities being attached). A waiting list will be formed and riders given a place upon withdrawals. PLEASE DO NOT ASK TO BE HELD A PLACE VIA EMAIL OR PHONE.

Two consecutive jump heights may be entered

To be eligible for the Height Champion prize the rider must compete in both classes for that height.

One horse per rider only (this allows more riders to be accepted).

Any ill treatment of horse/s or inappropriate behaviour towards stewards, judges etc will incur instant elimination.

Horses **MUST** be walked in all parking areas and on pathways to and from parking and competition areas.

Practice jumps may **ONLY** be jumped with the Red flag on the riders right.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF EACH RIDER ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DOING THE RIDERS GEAR CHECK.

The organizers have the right to ask a rider to dismount if the organizers feel the rider and horse are riding in an unsafe manner.

A PARENT OR GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL TIMES. THE NOMINATED PARENT OR GUARDIAN MUST SIGN INDEMNITY FORM A AND FORM B AND RETURN WITH THE ENTRIES.

Entry fees are non refundable after the closing date unless a Doctors or Vets certificate is supplied.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS:

- Fawn, Cream or White jodphurs, approved smooth soled riding boots, approved safety helmet, school shirt, tie and jumper (optional)
- Leather gaiters or long boots (NOT suede Chapettes) may be worn by any competitor.
- Riders MUST wear a safety approved helmet under the new regulations of EA and PCNSW for 2017) – helmets will be checked at the marshall gate and riders will NOT be allowed to ride should helmets not meet regulations.**
