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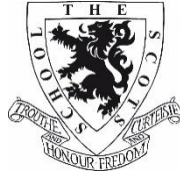

A number of Music Scholarships are available to students entering Year 7 to 11. These awards will be made to students who show particular ability on a musical instrument. Orchestral instruments are considered favourably, but students who make piano or voice their main instrument may also apply.

Students considered for these Scholarships will sit the ACER Scholarship tests to be held on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2018 and perform in an audition as part of their Scholarship Application. Candidates will be contacted by the School regarding audition dates.

It is a pre-requisite of all students accepting a Music Scholarship that they will study Music as an elective subject at Year 10 level and participate in musical activities of the School to Year 12

MY AUDITION TIME AND DATE.....

Audition will include:

1. A performance on student's major instrument playing two (2) contrasting pieces e.g. Classical & Contemporary. (Students can perform on minor instrument also if they wish.)

2. Aural Test, appropriate to student's practical grade passed.

3. Theory Test, appropriate to student's practical grade passed.
