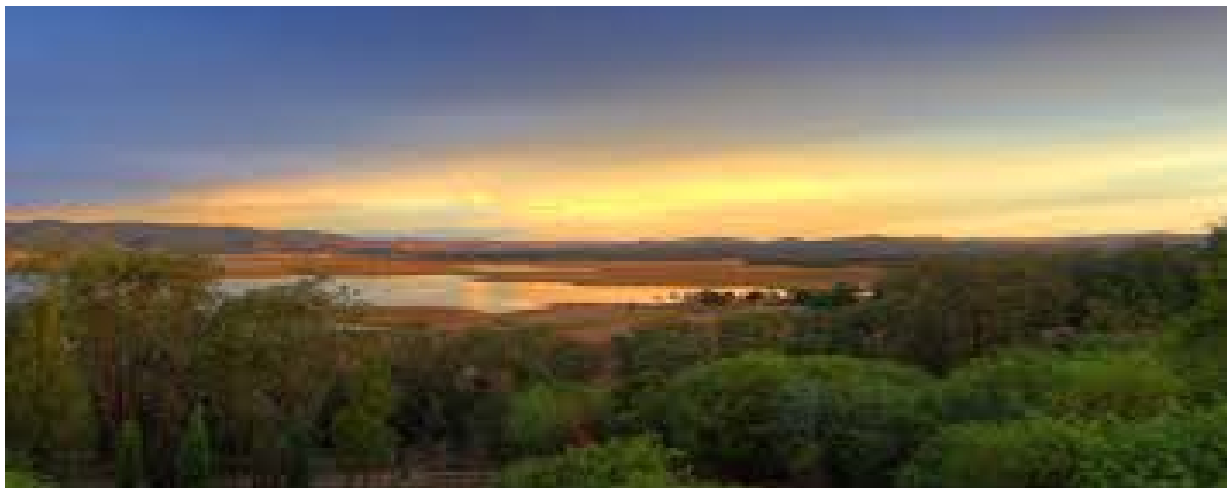

1. Saturday afternoon meet at the Steve Tobin Centre for drinks and nibbles at 5pm. *Please note -there is a \$12/car fee to enter the Lake Burrendong Holiday Park if you are not paying for accommodation on site.*
2. Dinner at the Steve Tobin Centre, 6.00pm till late this is the main social event. Cost will be \$30/head Adults & \$15/head for children under 12 years. This will include meat and salads and also dessert. All drinks are BYO.
3. Breakfast on Sunday @ Steve Tobin Function Centre BBQ from 8am.This is included in the cost of the ticket for Saturday night.
