SPORT TRAINING

Normal Thursday afternoon sport training is scheduled (3:30 – 5:00pm) for Year 7 and 8 students on the first day of school. Students will change into their sport uniform for training.

SETTING UP STUDENT DEVICES

All student devices will need to be set up prior to use on the new network. This will occur under the guidance of the ICT Team during the first two Orientation Days.

PHONES

Students will not be allowed to use their mobile phones whilst on campus between 8.25am and 3.20pm. If a K-6 student needs to bring a mobile phone to school, they are to hand it to their Class or Core teacher where it will be placed in a basket for the day. They need to collect it at the end of the school day.

Year 7 and 8 students must place their (turned off) mobile phone in their locker at the start of the school day and not take it out or use it until 3.20pm. It is the student's responsibility to keep their locker secure and will need to supply their own combination lock. If a child is seen using a mobile phone at school between 8.25am and 3.20pm their phone will be confiscated and given to the Head of School for a week.
