Senior Leave Form

This form must be signed by parents/caregivers/guardians before a boarder will be allowed to depart from The Scots School Bathurst grounds on Senior Leave.

Senior Leave is always at the discretion of the respective Housemaster and Director of Boarding and if there are concerns about the validity and appropriateness of the leave then permission may be refused.

Senior leave is defined as leave by Year 11/12 students for Friday evening, Saturday/Saturday evening or Sunday.

Senior leave allows Year 11/12 students only to leave the school grounds for a period of time negotiated with their Housemaster where they must **return** to their respective boarding house.

Senior leave is without staff supervision and does not require parental consent as the Housemaster will be granted the authority to allow leave with the signed Senior Leave Form by parents/caregivers/guardians.

Senior Leave is conditional;

- students are not allowed to travel in other student vehicles unless prior permission from both parties has been submitted in writing to their respective Housemaster
- students are not allowed to consume alcohol under any circumstances
- students must adhere to the time and place negotiated between themselves and their Housemaster
- the resident staff member on duty must be notified and the Leave Sheet signed

Senior leave excludes overnight leave which requires separate parental permission to be granted on each and every occasion.

Reasons for leave may include:

- dinner with day students
- going to the cinema
- watching a rugby/netball game
- shopping
- visiting friends
- etc.
